- Composting is an inexpensive way of adding nutrients back into the soil to improve its texture, structure, aeration ability and water holding capacity, and can save time and money spent on yard waste bags!
- Lakewood City Ordinance 1783.12 allows composting in the rear yard if it is a reasonable distance from thoroughfares, kept in orderly condition, and doesn't blow around or emit objectionable odors.

(with lid) 135 gallons
(30" x 36")

Ultimate Dirt Machine

(Digester) 80 gallons
(25" x 39")

Compost Bin

- Accepts most yard waste
- Processes some clean food scraps. See Compost Do's and Don'ts in District's Composting Guide.
- Creates soil amendment to be used in garden and landscaping
- Maintenance required
- Price \$50

Yard waste best in here.

Digester Bin

- Accepts most yard waste
- Processes all food scraps
- Can add pet waste, although should only be placed near non-edible landscaping
- Creates a small amount of soil amendment, but depends on the amount of yard waste added
- Very limited maintenance
- Price \$50

Food waste best in here.
