DID YOU KNOW?

Measuring 69 feet tall and 198 inches around the trunk, Lakewood is home to the **LARGEST BLACK LOCUST TREE** in the state of Ohio! The tree is located near St. James Church on Detroit Ave.. Since 1940, American Forests has documented the largest known specimens of every native and naturalized tree in the United States. Each Big Tree receives a score based on trunk circumference, crown spread and total height. Visit www.ohiodnr.com for more info.
