



In accordance with Mandatory Recycling Ordinance 1777.03 No person receiving municipal solid waste collection services in the City shall fail to separate all recyclable materials from other refuse. Recycling Guidelines are established by the Director of Public Works. The Division of Refuse and Recycling provides weekly curbside recycling collection to all residential properties (apartments included) on the regular collection day. Call (216) 252-4322 for the collection day in your area.

## New! It is OK to combine paper and mixed recycle together (in blue or clear see-through plastic bags) for Lakewood's Curbside Recycling Collection!



**PAPER:** Newspaper, junk mail, magazines, catalogs, school & office paper, paperback, hardbound & phone books, food & beverage boxes (i.e. cereal, pop, beer)

**Corrugated Cardboard**  
 Flatten and tie with string or pack inside other boxes  
**NO Pizza Boxes!**

**Plastic bottles & clear containers**  
 Recycle Symbol and Numbers 1 – 7  
 CD cases are ok, but **NO Styrofoam!**

**NEW!** Take standard packaging Styrofoam (EPS 6 only) to Lakewood's Drop-Off Facility for recycling!

All drink and food cans, aluminum foil, aerosols  
 Rinse cans and ensure aerosols are empty



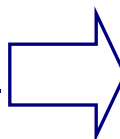

Glass jars and bottles (Rinsed)  
**NO broken glass!**

**Separate these recyclable materials from your solid waste!**  
**Package together for Lakewood's Curbside Recycling Collection!**

**Combine paper & mixed recycle together!**  
Use these to package your recyclables  
 Package securely to prevent litter!



- Blue or clear see-through plastic bags (tie closed)
- Plastic grocery bags (tie together into a bunch)
- Flatten cardboard; tie into bundles with string, or
- Flatten cardboard: pack inside other boxes.

**Throw these away as trash** Styrofoam, waxed paper, wax-coated or plastic lined cartons or boxes, frozen food packaging, light bulbs, broken glass, window glass, ceramics, coat hangers, spiral bindings, food, pizza boxes, food soiled items, small appliances, diapers, paper towels, paper napkins, and tissues. Recycle standard packing Styrofoam (EPS 6 only) at the drop-off facility.

**Do not use** Recycle bins, garbage cans, paper yard waste bags, or trash bags to contain recycle; they slow collection. Do not use boxes or paper bags for mixed recycle; they fall apart when damp, cause litter, and slow collection

**Size and Weight Limits** Bag Size: 30 gallon or less; Box or Bundle size: 2-foot x 2-foot; Weight: 30-pounds or less.

Place recyclables by the curb (not sidewalk) between 6:00 p.m. the night before collection and 6:30 a.m. on collection day. Set recyclables away from trash so they are easily recognized. See reverse side for Yard Waste Guidelines.
