Citizens Police Academy

This program is presented to residents of Lakewood who are interested in learning more about the Division of Police. The Academy is 12 weeks long. Classes will be held once a week for 2 hours. There is no fee to attend.

During the sessions, students are presented with information from a number of speakers to familiarize them with a variety of policing issues in Lakewood. In addition to speakers from the Division of Police, the Department of Law and Judge Carroll also address the class. At the end of each session the graduates are permitted to schedule a ride-along with a patrol officer for one evening.

Eligibility

- Must be 21 years of age
- Must reside or work within the City of Lakewood
- Must have no more than six points on your driving record
- Must have no Felony and/or serious Misdemeanor Convictions
- Applicants are subject to a background check
