## Malley's moves HQ back to Lakewood

**LAKWOOD** — Malley's Chocolates is bringing its headquarters back to Lakewood where it all began. The popular candy and ice cream business will move its offices from Brook Park to 1865 Victoria Ave. by the end of the year.

Mike Malley founded his flagship confection and ice cream store in Lakewood back in 1935, opening a second location a few years later. The business now has 18 stores throughout Northeast Ohio.

The new headquarters,

which will sit right next door to the Lakewood Malley's ice cream parlor and candy shop, was Malley's original candy kitchen.

Malley's President Dan Malley said the 2,160-square-foot space will house about six employees. He did not respond to requests for further comment.

The move will make room for more growth at the Brook Park site where Malley's has been headquartered since 1990.

"We continue to have tre-

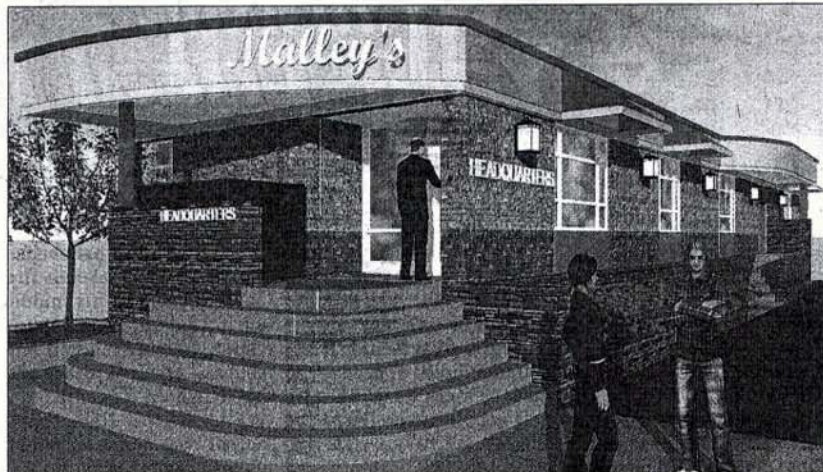
mendous growth and need to expand our operations in Brook Park," Malley said in release from the city of Lakewood. "To make room for more of our customers' favorites, we're moving our office headquarters back to Lakewood — they city my grandfather started Malley's Chocolates in 1935."

Jeffrey Grusenmeyer of architectural firm Jeffrey A. Grusenmeyer and Associates, Inc. said the team is planning to add stone facing to the original building along with larger windows and a grand staircase in front.

"We're doing a total renovation of the interior for office space and extensive renovation of the exterior," he said.
