



2015 Parking Meter Permits for Business January 1 – June 30, 2015

The City of Lakewood, in an on-going effort to assist our business community in finding easily accessible parking, launched a Parking Meter Permit pilot program in May 2011. Businesses along Detroit Avenue and Madison Avenue that did not have access to off-street parking on the property where the business is located were eligible to apply for the program. The program was implemented to make it convenient for owners and employees to park near their place of employment without having to feed parking meters during the course of the work day. Due to its success, the City is continuing the program into 2013.

The City has made available 100 permits at a total at a cost of \$250 each. The permits are on a first come, first serve basis to qualified applicants with a maximum of two permits per business. Applications must be submitted by the business owner or owners and will be reviewed by the Department of Planning and Development. All applications will be evaluated based on need and limitations of any available parking.

The permit does not guarantee a space at a specific meter and is intended for on-street meters only. The City recommends that business owners and their employees defer to customer convenience and make every effort to park at meters on adjacent side streets and other meters appropriate for long term parking and not the meters directly in front of the stores and businesses.

This permit may be transferred between vehicles of the business owner or employees of that business. The permits are issued to the business and not specific people or vehicles. The permit must hang from the rear view mirror so that it is clearly visible through the rear window while parked. Parking enforcement officers are not responsible for searching out permits. Vehicles with permits that are not displayed properly or cannot be seen because of tinted windows or other obstructions may be ticketed.

Street meter parking is subject to restrictions:

- Parking Meter permits are non-refundable or replaceable once issued.
- Vehicles must fit within one parking stall.
- Commercial vehicles and extended or oversized vehicles are not allowed.

Street meter parking permits do not allow vehicles to park in any:

- loading or delivery designated areas
- meters located on private parking lots
- metered streets when snow bans are in effect
- temporarily unusable (bagged or inoperable)
