Old House Fair

Ms. Rudge reported that the Lakewood Old House Fair would be held on May 3 from 10:00 A.M. to 3:00 P.M. Ms. Rudge, Ms. Schickler, and Mr. Dolce will staff the LHAB table and answer questions on the City's preservation ordinance, conducting property history research, and guidelines for appropriate maintenance practices. Ms. Rudge will hold a seminar on property history research.

2014 Preservation Awards

Ms. Rudge presented the Board with 17 potential preservation award projects. Each project was accompanied with photographs of the restorations. The Board deliberated on the candidate projects selecting 15 for awards. The awards will be given to the property owners at the May 19 City Council meeting.

Historic Preservation Joint Activities

In February, the Board, and representatives from the Lakewood Historical Society and Lakewood Alive discussed their organizations' efforts to advocate historic preservation in

the community. Mr. Weber participated in follow-up meetings with an ad hoc committee drawn from the organizations to refine and eliminate overlapping efforts as well as propose reallocation of responsibilities. Mr. Weber reported that the first meetings have been productive. Discussions are planned to continue.
