**Historic Preservation Joint Activities**

In February, the Board, and representatives from the Lakewood Historical Society and Lakewood Alive discussed their organizations' efforts to advocate historic preservation in the community. Mr. Weber participated in follow-up meetings with an ad hoc committee drawn from the organizations to refine and eliminate overlapping efforts as well as propose reallocation of responsibilities. Mr. Weber reported that recommendations for roles and responsibilities and potential joint undertakings are complete and will be submitted to all of the participating organizations.

**Lakewood Masonic Temple Historic Property Nomination (15300 Detroit Ave.)**

Mr. Sicha reported that the Masonic Temple administrators have decided to place their request for nomination on hold pending decisions on window repairs.

The Board recommended that the best way to secure endorsement for a historic district was to encourage discourse among the advocates and their neighbors to rouse enthusiasm for the project. Ms. Schickler will coordinate and facilitate these discussions as they evolve.
