The Lakewood Police Citizens' Academy is a 12 week program starting Thursday, January 10, 2019 and continuing through March 28, 2019. The Academy will be held from 6:30PM to 9:00 PM at the Lakewood Police Department on each Thursday.

The Citizens Police Academy is for Lakewood residents or people who work in Lakewood, 21 years of age or older, who are interested in learning more about the Division of Police. There is no fee to attend. During the sessions, students will be presented with information from a number of speakers to familiarize them with a variety of policing issues in Lakewood.

In addition to speakers from the Division of Police, Mayor Summers, and a representative from the Law Department will address the class. Participants are permitted to schedule a ride-along with a patrol officer for one evening.
