BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY OF LAKEWOOD, OHIO:


Section 1. That this Council recognizes John Uchaker on achieving the rank of Eagle Scout – the highest rank within the Boy Scouts of America.

Section 2. That this Council recognizes John's proud and supportive parents, his many encouraging troop leaders and all the many peers and mentors who have motivated John on his scouting journey.




Section 2. That this Council and Administration does hereby express that Chief Malley experience an enjoyable retirement, free from the weight of his many responsibilities as Chief.

WHEREAS, Fire Prevention Week effectively serves to remind us all of the simple actions we can take to stay safe from kitchen fires at home; now, therefore,


BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY OF LAKEWOOD, OHIO:


