

A RESOLUTION to recognize Lakewood High School senior Lillian Horschke for her creativity and artistic ability that allowed her to earn a Silver Medal in the Scholastic Art & Writing Awards competition presented by the Alliance for Young Artists & Writers.

WHEREAS, this competition is the nation's longest-running and most prestigious recognition program for creative teens in grades 7–12. More than 340,000 pieces of art were submitted for the contest and Lillian’s efforts placed her in the top 1% of entrants.

WHEREAS, Lillian won her national Silver Medal in Printmaking for her print “Evelyn,” which also earned Gold Medal status in the regional Scholastic competition. She also won Silver Medal status on two other pieces submitted to the regional competition,
