



**NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING
FY19 FEDERAL FUNDING**

On Wednesday, October 24, 2018 at 6pm Lakewood's Citizens Advisory Committee (CAC) will hold the second of (2) Public Hearings prior to submission of the City's Fiscal Year 2019 (FY19) One-Year Action Plan to the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD). The hearing begins at 6pm in the East Conference Room at Lakewood City Hall (12650 Detroit Avenue). Citizen attendance is strongly encouraged and feedback is solicited during a Public Comment Period at the conclusion of the hearing.

The CAC reviews requests for federal Community Development Block Grant (CDBG), Emergency Solutions Grant (ESG), and HOME Investment Partnerships (HOME) funding submitted by City departments and not-for-profit organizations then makes recommendations to City Council regarding the allocation of these funds.

Topics include descriptions of Lakewood's federally-funded programs; preliminary estimates of the City's FY19 CDBG, ESG, and HOME funding; the citizen participation process through which federal funds are allocated; and a review of Lakewood's community and economic development needs, goals and objectives.
