FY21 City of Lakewood Federal Funding Process

As an entitlement jurisdiction participating in the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development's (HUD) Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) and Emergency Solutions Grant (ESG) programs, the City of Lakewood seeks proposals for CDBG- and ESG-eligible Fiscal Year 2021 projects. CDBG and ESG funding is restricted to not-for-profit organizations and units of general local government.

CDBG projects must principally benefit low-moderate income Lakewood residents and/or geographies. Eligible activities must develop decent affordable housing; create and maintain a suitable living environment; eliminate slum and blight conditions; provide critical public services; and expand economic opportunity.

ESG projects must provide very low-income persons with homelessness prevention or emergency shelter services accompanied by evidence-based case management and housing stability interventions.

Funding applications will be available by request from Lakewood's Department of Planning & Development beginning Friday, August 28, 2020.
