******OLD BUSINESS******

1. Public Safety Committee Report regarding Ordinances (To Be Provided)

#1 Public Safety Committee report regarding Ordinances 106-10 and 107-10 - Powers

The Public Safety Committee met this evening to consider items number 2 and 3 on our docket this evening. With respect to the first item, this is basically moving the section relating to bus stops and taxicab stands back into the criminal traffic violation part of our codified ordinances. We had moved it out...when we moved all of our parking violations we moved to decriminalize those for very good reasons this was picked up and moved along with those and now we've determined that it is a better tool in our toolbox to have it as a potential moving violation back in our criminal code. So, we're moving it back. That's what that first item is. We found one typographical error in section 1 instead of bust with a "t" stop, it is bus stop. That has been corrected and a corrected version has been given to the clerk. We recommended out of committee to substitute and pass the ordinance this evening that's on third reading here tonight.

The second item, item 3 on our agenda is section 351.01. This is again sort of on the traffic code update we did this past July. There were several sub section paragraphs (p) through (s) of 351.01 that were eliminated by typographical error and we need to put

those back in. We found one, actually one of our new councilmembers found a typographical error there in paragraph (r) there is a number 4 that mysteriously appeared in “designated”. Again, a substitute version of this has been prepared and presented to the clerk so we recommended unanimously to recommend passage of the substituted version this evening. That was all we had to deal with tonight so that’s all we’ll talk about.

Motion by Mr. Powers, seconded by Mr. Butler, to receive and file the report.

2. **ORDINANCE NO. 106-10** – AN ORDINANCE to move Section 351.20, Bus Stops; Taxicab Stands of the Codified Ordinances of the City of Lakewood out of the Parking Chapter to Chapter 331, Operation Generally as this section is often cited for a moving violation and should not be a civil parking violation. PLACED ON 1ST READING & REFERRED TO THE PUBLIC SAFETY COMMITTEE 12/6/10, 2ND 12/20/10) (Pg.3)

Motion by Mr. Butler, seconded by Ms. Madigan, to substitute Ordinance No. 106-10 with that brought forward that evening.

4. **ORDINANCE NO. 109-10** - AN ORDINANCE to establish the base salary of the mayor at One Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$100,000.00) per year pursuant to Article II, Section 5 of the Second Amended Charter of the City of Lakewood, and to establish the base salary of councilmember at Eleven Thousand Dollars (\$11,000.00) per year, plus an optional health-care benefits package not to exceed Three Thousand, Three Hundred Dollars (\$3,300.00) per year, pursuant to Article III, Section 3 of the Charter, for the purpose of adopting the recommendations of the Civil Service Commission dated December 20, 2010. (PLACED ON 1ST READING & REFERRED TO THE COMMITTEE OF THE WHOLE 12/20/10 (Pg.10)

Motion by Mr. Butler, seconded by Ms. Madigan, to place Ordinance No. 109-10 on 2nd Reading and refer back to the Committee of the Whole.
