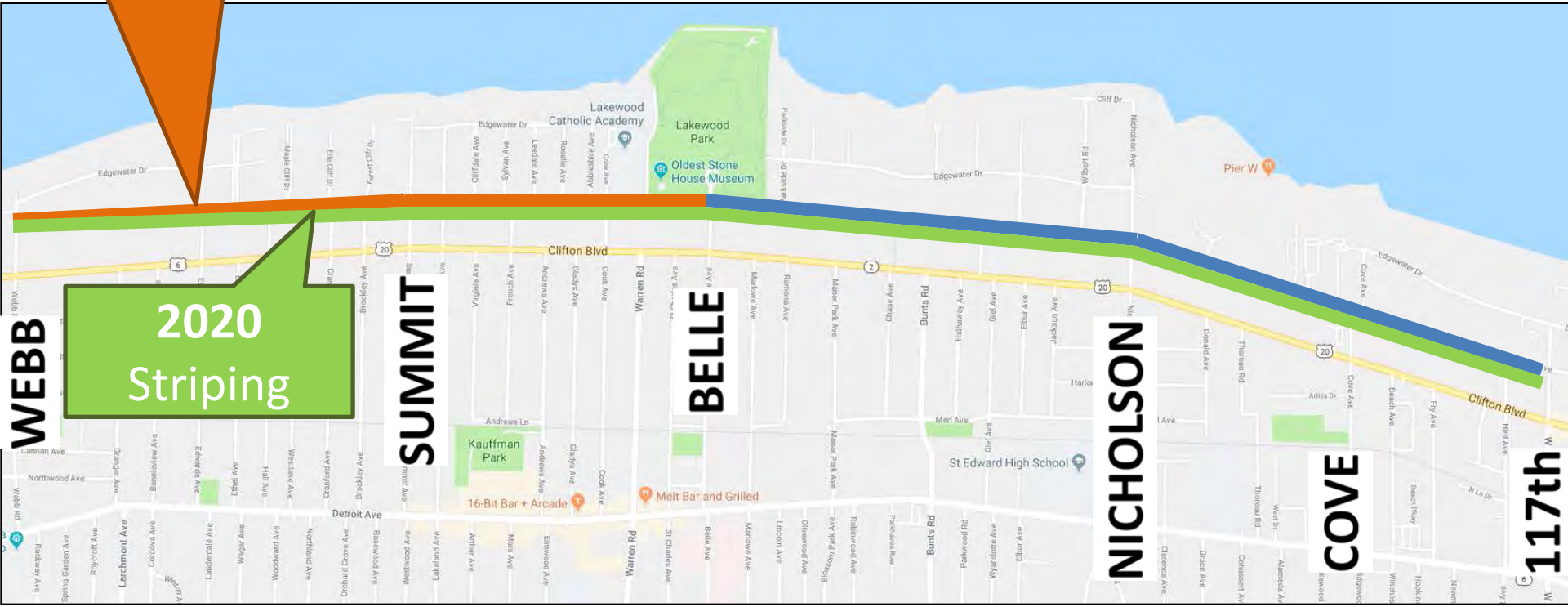

August 15th - Abbieshire to Belle Completion

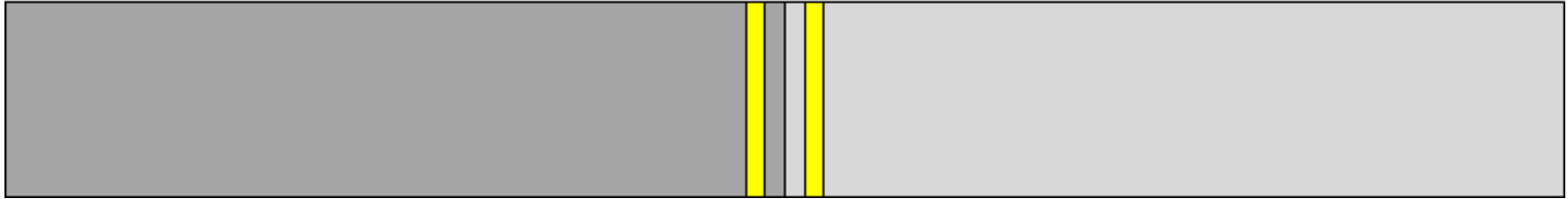
December 1st – Full Project Completion

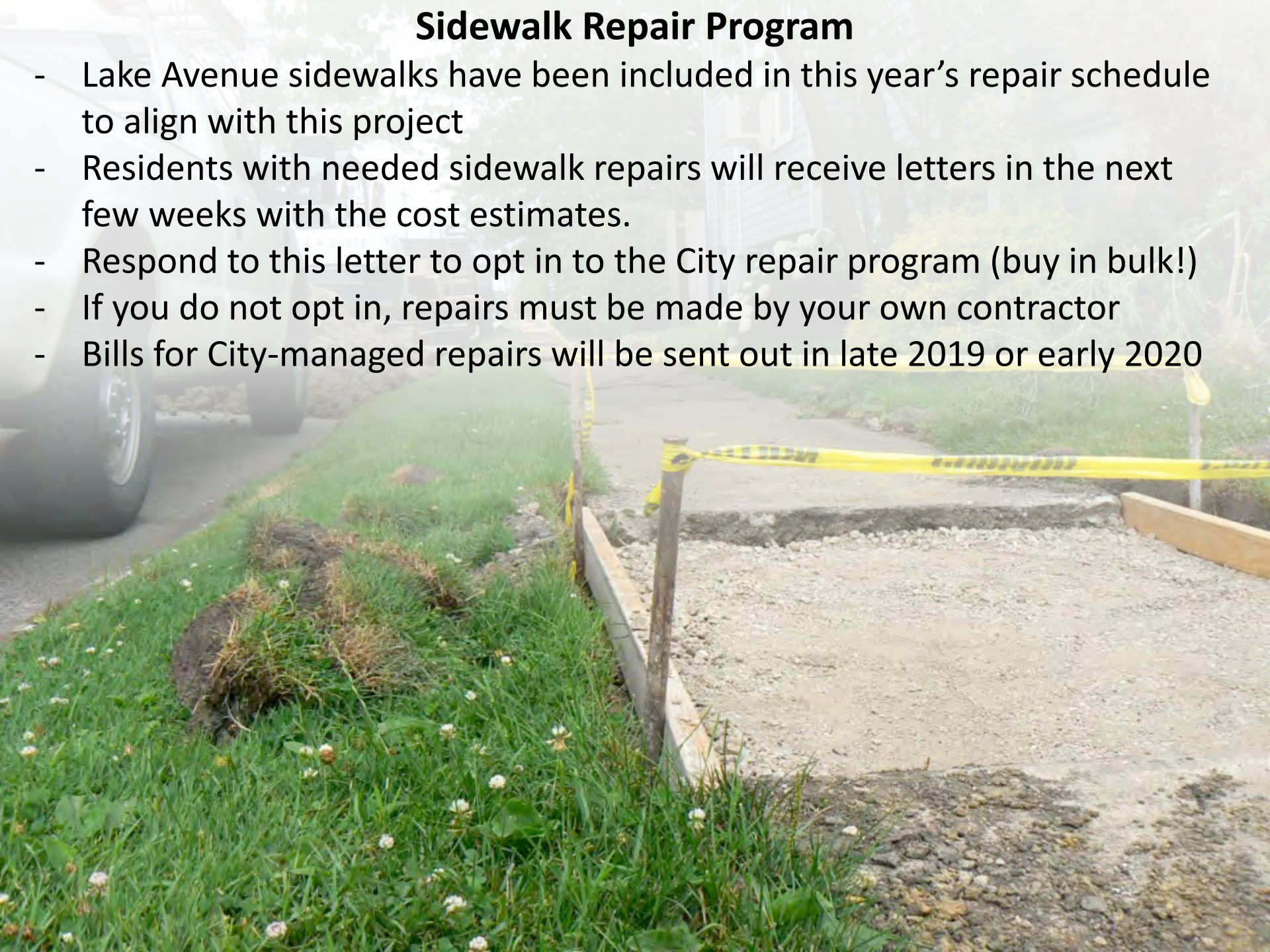

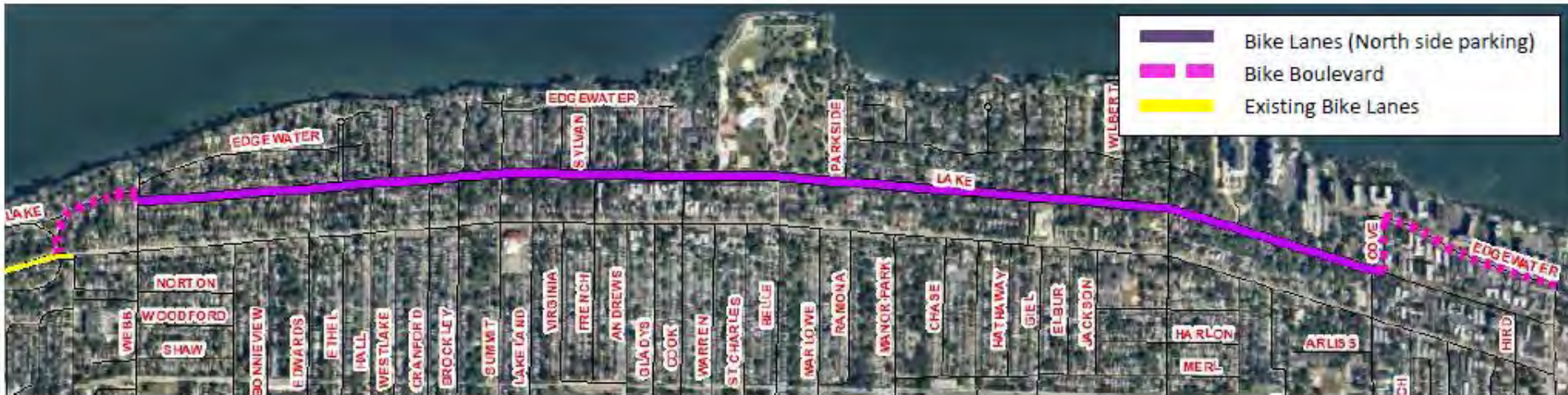

Sidewalk Repair Program

- Lake Avenue sidewalks have been included in this year's repair schedule to align with this project
- Residents with needed sidewalk repairs will receive letters in the next few weeks with the cost estimates.
- Respond to this letter to opt in to the City repair program (buy in bulk!)
- If you do not opt in, repairs must be made by your own contractor
- Bills for City-managed repairs will be sent out in late 2019 or early 2020



Final Re-Striping – Spring 2020

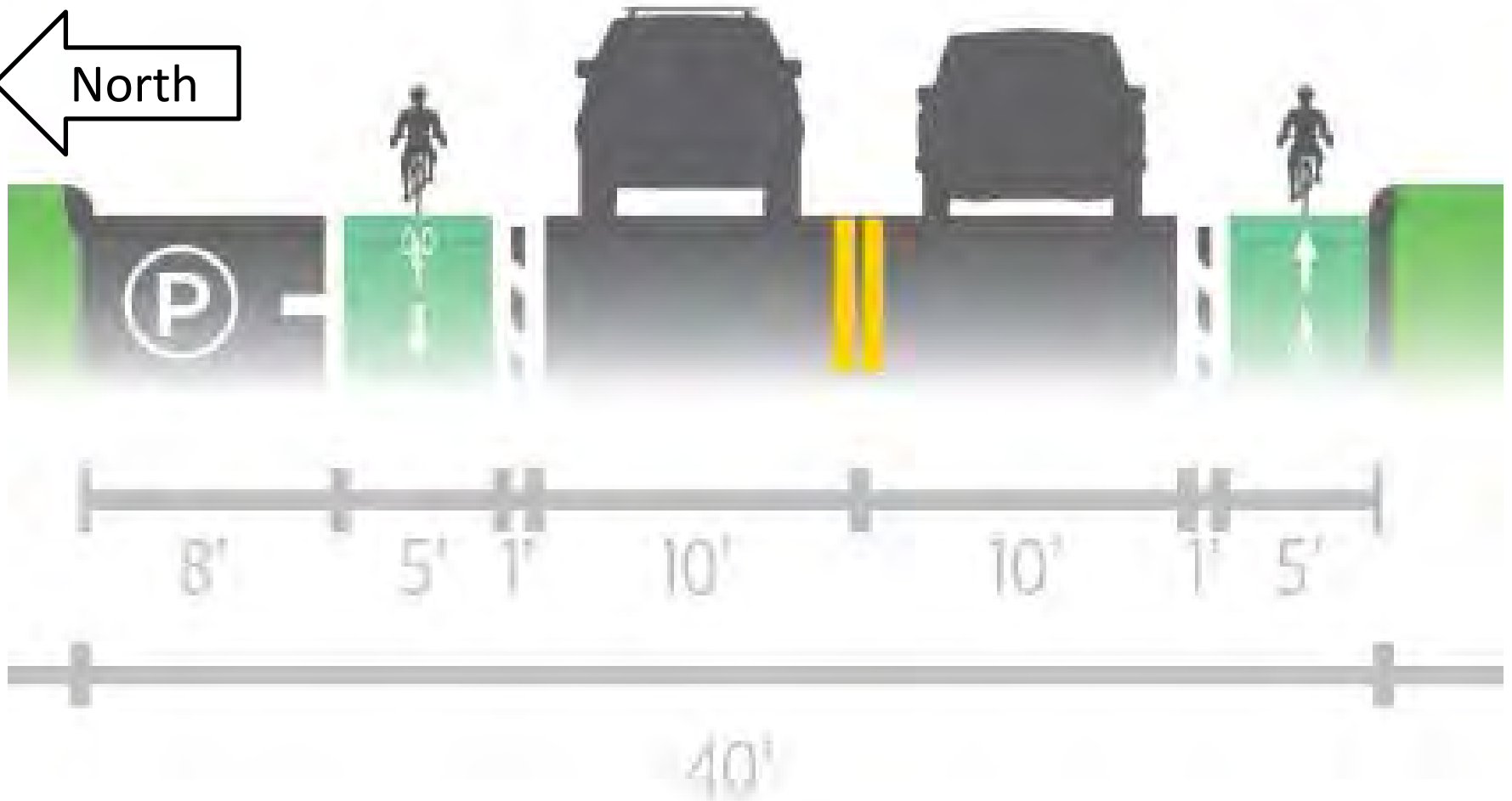
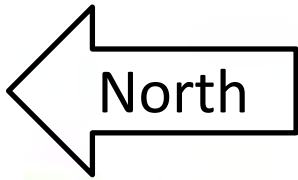


What we heard:

- Preserve two-sided parking in Gold Coast area
- Slow down traffic / reduce through traffic
- Eliminate passing on the right
- No bollards
- Preserve traffic flow
- Make it connected and useful

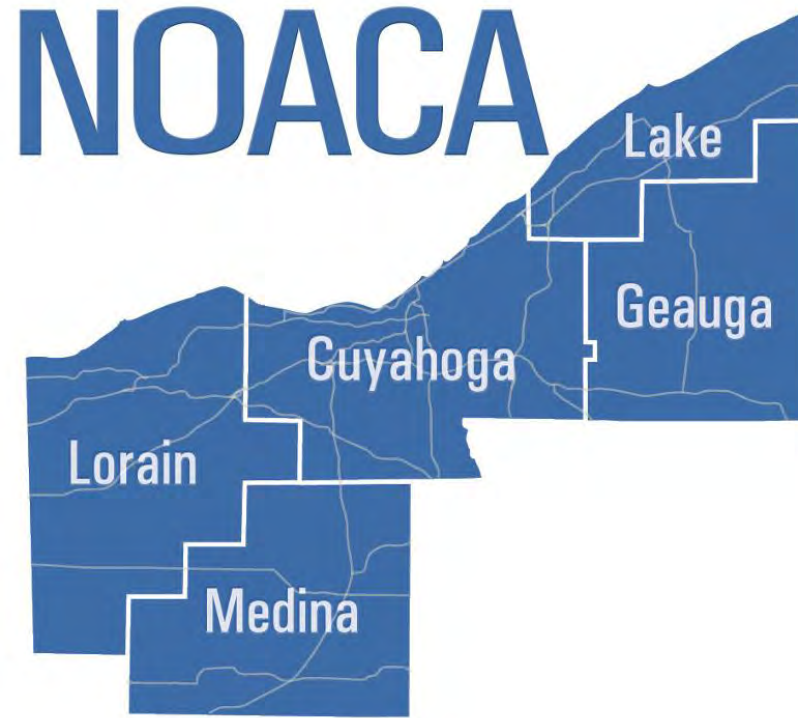
We will deliver:

- Two-sided parking in the Gold Coast
- Narrower lanes which should reduce speeding and passing
- No bollards
- Left turn lanes at key intersections
- Connections to Clifton Ext. and Edgewater Bikeways
