The Division of Aging provides a continuum of responsive core services and collaborates with key partners to provide necessary resources to help improve Lakewood's older residents overall health & well-being.



WHERE TO BEGIN

Each year we ask all individuals who wish to access Division of Aging services and programs to complete a Participant Intake Form (PIF) prior to participating in any services.

Activities & Programs, Congregate Meals and Transportation

Individuals of any residence who are 60 and older are eligible.

Home Delivered Meals

Lakewood Residents who are age 60 and older and homebound. An in-home Participant Intake is conducted by a social worker to determine eligibility.



Congregate Meals Served at Fedor Manor (East) & the Lawther Senior Center (West)

RESERVATIONS

Monthly menus are posted at each location. Reservations are required to be submitted by 3:00 p.m. on Wednesdays for the following week. Reservations may be made by the phone or using “My Senior Center” system at either location. First time visitors do not need to make a reservation.

CANCELATIONS

Please make any cancellations for meals AS SOON AS POSSIBLE. Your prompt cancellation will allow visitors on “standby” to participate. Numerous failures to cancel may impact future reservations.

Home Delivered Meals

RESERVATIONS

One meal a day will be delivered between the hours of 10:30 a.m. and 12:30 p.m. Monday through Friday. A signature by the participant or caregiver is required upon delivery.

CANCELATIONS

Please make any cancellations for meals AS SOON AS POSSIBLE. Volunteers are unable to leave meals if the participant is not home. Excessive failure to no show or cancel may impact enrollment in this service.

Medical Transportation

RESERVATIONS

Medical Transportation can be scheduled 3 weeks ahead of a medical appointment and no later than 3 business days prior to a medical appointment. At the time of reservation be prepared to provide the appointment date, time, address of appointment location, physician name & phone number, and if use of an assistive device is required. Participants are eligible to schedule up to four, one-way trips per week.

CANCELATIONS

All cancellations must be made by 4 p.m. the day before your scheduled trip

Non Medical Transportation

RESERVATIONS

For non– medical transport, reservations can be made by calling the Division of Aging Transportation.

CANCELATIONS

Cancellations or changes should be made AS SOON AS POSSIBLE prior to 8:30 a.m. the day of transport.
