Proposed Uses for CARES Act CDBG-CV & ESG-CV Funding

CARES Act Funding Allocations

The City of Lakewood received the following supplemental Community Development Block Grant (CDBG-CV) and Emergency Solutions Grant (ESG-CV) funding allocations via the Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security Act (CARES Act).

CDBG-CV	\$1,186,886
ESG-CV	\$601,062

The use of CDBG-CV and ESG-CV funds is restricted to activities already eligible under these programs that “prevent, prepare for, and respond to the COVID-19 pandemic” with the expectation that certain regulatory requirements will be relaxed to expedite the provision of assistance to very-low, low-, and low-moderate-income households.
