



Virtual Public Hearing Notice

CARES Act Community Development Block Grant & Emergency Solutions Grant Coronavirus Funding

The United States Department of Housing & Urban Development (HUD) requires local governments that receive Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) and Emergency Solutions Grant (ESG) funds to consider public comments regarding the proposed uses of these funds described in their five-year Consolidated Plans, Annual Action Plans, and amendments to these documents.

The City of Lakewood has received additional funding from both the Community Development Block Grant Coronavirus (CDBG-CV) and Emergency Solutions Grant Coronavirus (ESG-CV) programs in the amounts indicated below via the Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security Act (CARES Act), Public Law 116-136, enacted on March 27, 2020 in response to the economic fallout of the COVID-19 pandemic. CARES Act funding is restricted to activities already eligible under these programs that “prevent, prepare for, and respond to the COVID-19 pandemic.”
