The United States Department of Housing & Urban Development (HUD) requires local governments that receive Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) and Emergency Solutions Grant (ESG) funds to consider public comments regarding the proposed uses of these funds described in their five-year Consolidated Plans, Annual Action Plans, and amendments to these documents.

Notice is hereby given that Lakewood's Citizens Advisory Committee (CAC) will hold the third of (3) Public Hearings prior to submission of the City's Fiscal Year 2021 (FY21) One-Year Action Plan to the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) on Wednesday, October 28, 2020 at 6pm

Due to pandemic social distancing requirements, the hearing will be conducted virtually via the GoToMeeting platform. The CAC reviews requests for federal Community Development Block Grant (CDBG), Emergency Solutions Grant (ESG), HOME Investment Partnerships (HOME), and Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security (CARES) Act funding submitted by City departments and not-for-profit agencies then makes recommendations to Lakewood City Council regarding the allocation of these funds.

Hearing topics include descriptions of the CDBG, ESG, and HOME programs; preliminary estimates of funding the City anticipates receiving from these programs; Lakewood's citizen participation process with regard to federal funding; the City's housing and non-housing community development needs and goals and how they will be addressed with federal and non-federal funds in the coming year.
